The 2020 Terrenus Vinha da Serra is a field blend (Arinto, Fernão Pires, Bical, Roupeiro, Malvasia and Tamez in roughly 15% to 20% chunks) from centenarian vines at high altitude (750 meters). It fermented in a concrete egg and aged for nine months in 50% new French oak. It comes in at 13.5% alcohol. As much as I admire the winery's other whites, this is the one that I find most interesting most often because of its energy and freshness. It has fine concentration too, then grips the palate nicely. It's not as complex as the Vinhas Velhas, but everything else seems better. Since it is also two years younger than the Vinhas Velhas, perhaps it will catch up there too.
