Sourced in the Gedersdorf Vordernberg, where limestone and loess meet the sun, the 2022 Neuburger Reserve is a thrilling wine that has just one problem: since it is not allowed here to communicate the origin that characterizes the wine more than anything else, it has to be sold under the (internationally) unknown grape variety Neuburger, which is, to be honest, nearly unknown even under Austrian consumers. The nose is pure, clear and exciting in its reduction and precision, its focus on the essentials: chalk meets the sun. Lush, refined and very elegant on the palate, this is a full-bodied and mouth-filling yet refined and precisely juicy Vordernberg with a Burgundian twist. Not quoting the most famous terroirs in Burgundy but the finest from the under-the-radar regions. Trust your taste, so taste it! And smell the persistent salinity that only ends because I have to make a point now. 13% stated alcohol. Screw cap. Tasted in January 2024.
