Bründlmayer's 2022 Grüner Veltliner Ried Vordernberg is from a steep vineyard facing toward the high noon sun. This heat, however, is encountered by northwest winds, and since Veltliner is an Austrian variety, it can deal with the antagonism. The wine wraps its ripe and elegant fruit into a potpourri of finely crushed stones, wheat bread and, well, cool winds that add some floral/herbal nuances. The wine is lush and refined on the palate, round and saline, in a quiet flow and flanked by remarkably fine, mineral acidity. The finish is still saline and reveals a delicate tannin and mineral structure. The aftertaste is beautifully bitter and long. The Vordernberg is on the same level as the Moosburgerin, but it builds the bridge from Austrian to Scandinavian cuisine. 13% stated alcohol. Natural cork. Tasted in January 2024.
